Alternatively, you may be in the process of gaining a young people's counselling qualification and seeking a placement during your training.

As a volunteer counsellor at Frome College, you will work alongside key personnel in our Student Services Department during term time to provide one-to-one, short-term counselling to students who may have self-referred or have been identified by staff/parents or carers as someone who could benefit from such support.

To be considered for this role, you must be

- qualified to diploma level and be an experienced practitioner, currently counselling either adults or young people **and/or**
- qualified to diploma level, be an experienced practitioner and be in the process of undertaking a further counselling training specifically designed to work with young people
- currently participating in ongoing Clinical Supervision to support your counselling caseload
- experienced in providing previous, short-term counselling contracts and be willing to work within the context of school setting
- confident working within clear professional boundaries
- be able to volunteer for a minimum of 3 hours per week during term time
- willing to undertake mandatory safeguarding and Prevent training
