### Costs and next steps

Current Cost of Registration at Gold level is a £28 fee which goes to the National DofE Organisation plus a £5 fee which goes to the Somerset Operating Authority. Expeditions usually cost about £15 per day (8 days needed), spread over 2 years. The residential section (4 nights and 5 days minimum away from home) – cost varies from free to several hundred pounds, depending on what is chosen. All other activities are personal choices – costs will vary accordingly.

On receipt of this form, we will contact you using the email addresses given. We will accept all students who are in the correct age range, but we do expect that any previous DofE levels started should be completed before starting gold. We can help with getting previous awards finished if necessary.

Once accepted, we will open parent pay for you to pay the registration fee (£33). On receipt of payment, the Gold Level on eDofE will be opened .

### Note:

Data supplied on this form and in eDofE and information about DofE activities recorded in eDofE will be used by the DofE Charity, the Licensed Organisation and DofE centre to monitor and manage DofE participation and progress by young people and manage and support Leaders.
