Re: Warner Bros. Studio Tour London - The Making of Harry Potter

Frome College Media Studies Department has organised a trip to visit Warner Bros. Studios in London on **Monday 4 November 2024**. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to view some of the amazing sets used in the films, explore the collection of beautifully crafted iconic props and discover the artistry in every stitch of the Wizarding World's costumes! This trip was originally offered to Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11 Media Studies students, but we now have some extra spaces available, which we are offering to all Year 9 students.

We will be travelling by coach to London, leaving Frome College at 7am, and we will be back at approximately 6pm. Students can be collected from the main car or be permitted to walk home. Although food is available to buy at the venue, we highly recommend that students bring their own packed lunch, snacks and drinks with them to avoid queuing and additional expense. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please let me know so that I can arrange a packed lunch for them.

The tour includes the entrance ticket to Warner Bros. Studio Tour London and a 45-minute lesson, planned and taught by qualified teachers in Warner's own purpose-built classroom. There is also a free green screen broomstick experience.

The visit will be covered by the normal Somerset Education Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad insurance arrangements are the same as for pupils in school, i.e. that the Authority only provides cover against proven or agreed negligence by the Authority and its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for school activities in the UK.

The cost of this trip is £48.00 which will cover the cost of the ticket, travel and insurance. To secure the tickets, it is essential that payment is made by the **deadline of Tuesday 22 October 2024**.

Payment for this trip can be made by ParentPay. By making your payment by ParentPay please be aware this is also used as acceptance of your parental consent and that you are satisfied with the arrangements outlined above. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information as this information is taken from our college database.
