The funding is to cover 50% of the cost of 1-2-1 weekly 30-minute instrumental lessons for one academic year.

Applications for the funding will be considered by the Head of Music and a panel made up of senior leadership and a governor.

The funding will be reviewed termly to ensure the recipient is attending their lessons and making good progress. Unexplained poor attendance may result in the funding being withdrawn
